# \$2,500 Student Scholarship

A \$2,500 grant has been established to honor the late Dr. Larry J. Alexander. Dr. Alexander was a mentor and friend to many and a leader in optometry. ### To be eligible for the Dr. Larry J. Alexander Scholarship for Education, a student must:

- Be a student in good academic standing;
- Submit a paper, written in English, not to exceed 1,000 words addressing the following question:
